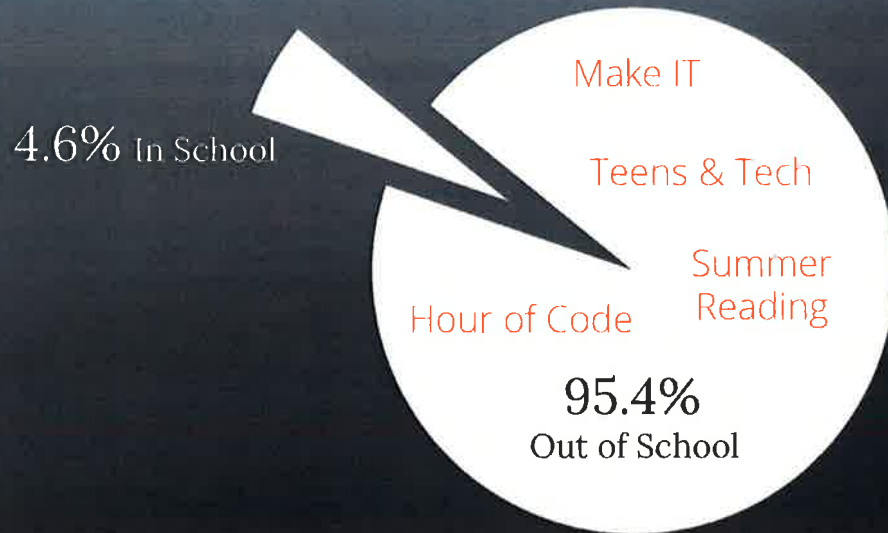

Shantel Goodall is the Academic Programs Manager for Idaho PTTC and is also a representative for additional organizations which include the 4 + 4 Program, Get Forward Program, Mastery Assessment Program and

Early Completers Program These programs encourage high school students for enriched courses, dual credit courses, and technical training. More information can be found at www.idoe.edu/education.

Idaho PTTC just enrolled 95 new students for the Spring semester. Opportunities are being held for students at whatever college is closest to them. Campus tours are being provided along with other informational sessions which supplies are being handled out.
