

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24904

This bill amends the Idaho Board of Architectural Examiner's licensure by endorsement statute to allow architects licensed in other states to qualify for a license by endorsement or a temporary permit if they can pass an examination approved by the board. This will allow the board to consider applicants for endorsement licensure who may have taken an examination for licensure in another jurisdiction other than the examination which is required by the state of Idaho.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no impact to the General Fund or to the Idaho Bureau of Occupational License's dedicated fund. There is no impact because these applications are considered by the Board during scheduled Board meetings.
