RS 25135:	Rep. Malek presented RS 25135 , proposed legislation which updates the reporting requirements for the city treasurer to the city council, taking into account the use of computers and allowing the quarterly treasurer's report to be posted on a city's website to satisfy publication requirements.	
MOTION:	Rep. Redman made a motion to introduce RS 25135.

VOTE ON MOTION:	Chairman Perry called for a vote on the motion to introduce RS 25135. Motion carried by voice vote.	
RS 25205:	Rep. Erpelding presented RS 25205 , a proposed constitutional amendment to lower the constitutional requirements for bonds from local jurisdictions from two-thirds to 60% of voters. He noted jurisdictions, particularly in eastern Idaho, have had a great deal of trouble passing bonds, especially for schools. Idaho is one of only two states in the nation that has a two-thirds requirement for bonds. He noted the proposed legislation lowers the threshold to 60%, which is still a sizeable majority, but not a supermajority. Rep. Erpelding argued the higher the requirement for a vote action, the more power is placed in the hands of a minority of voters who are able to sway the outcome and the best way to support more local control is to lower the required threshold.	
MOTION:	Rep. McCrostie made a motion to introduce RS 25205. Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Luker, Barbieri and Kingsley requested to be recorded as voting NAY.
