2 RELATING TO FIREARMS SAFETY; AMENDING CHAPTER 16, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY
3 THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-1628, IDAHO CODE, TO AUTHORIZE AND EN-
4 COURAGE A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ADOPT AN ELECTIVE COURSE IN FIREARMS SAFETY
5 EDUCATION AND TO AUTHORIZE INSTRUCTORS.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Chapter 16, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
8 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
9 ignated as Section 33-1628, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

10 33-1628. FIREARMS SAFETY EDUCATION IN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY
11 SCHOOLS. The board of trustees of a school district is encouraged to es-
12 tablish and maintain a firearms safety education course for primary and
13 secondary school students. The trustees may adopt an elective course of
14 instruction developed by the department of fish and game, a law enforcement
15 agency, or a national firearms association as its firearms safety education
16 course. Instructors from the department of fish and game, a law enforcement
17 agency or a national firearms association, or a person recognized by the
18 trustees as having expertise in firearms safety education may provide the
19 course instruction.
