SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.B. NO. 474

AMENDMENT TO THE BILL

1
2 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 17 through 40; and delete page
3 2, and insert:

4 "SECTION 3. That Section 67-509, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
5 amended to read as follows:

6 67-509. PUBLICATION OF LEGISLATIVE JOURNALS AND SESSION LAWS -- DIS-
7 TRIBUTION AND REPORT. (1) On the first legislative day or as soon thereafter
8 as the speaker shall have been elected, it shall be the duty of the president
9 of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives each to appoint
10 a printing committee for his body whose duties shall be, in addition to its
11 duties prescribed by the rules of said bodies respectively, to immediately
12 meet in joint session and to provide for the publication of the journals of
13 the two (2) houses of the legislature. Said committee shall determine the
14 form of the journals to be used, the size of the type, the number to be dis-
15 tributed to each member of the legislature and the method of distribution,
16 the number of journals to be made available for sale through the secretary of
17 state's office, and the manner in which the journals are to be bound for the
18 permanent copies of the journal. All costs incurred in publishing the jour-
19 nals shall be a proper charge against the legislative fund, unless an appro-
20 priation for such purpose has been made.

21 (2) The joint printing committee of the senate and house of representa-
22 tives shall exist to print, publish, and distribute the session laws. The
23 joint printing committee will consist of the printing committees of each
24 house. The chairmen of the respective judiciary and rules committees, or
25 their designee, will chair their house's printing committee and cochair the
26 joint printing committee.

27 (3) Prior to the final adjournment of a regular legislative session,
28 the joint printing committee must meet and determine the proper method of
29 printing and preserving the session laws of that legislative session. The
30 joint printing committee must give consideration to the cost, accessibil-
31 ity, and preservation of the session laws. The joint printing committee will
32 provide sufficient physical copies of session laws.

33 (4) The published session laws must include the bills, concurrent res-
34 olutions, joint resolutions, petitions and memorials enacted or adopted
35 during the legislative session. In addition, the session laws must include
36 amendments to the constitution adopted at the preceding general election,
37 and bills, concurrent resolutions, joint resolutions, and memorials enacted
38 or adopted during an intervening extraordinary session of the legislature.
39 The published session laws must include a title page, a table of contents,

1 certificate pages, tables of amended and repealed statutes, an index of con-
2 tents, and a list of each member of the senate and house of representatives.

3 (5) Prior to the final adjournment of a regular legislative session,
4 the printing committee of each house must meet jointly to consider the proper
5 method to print and preserve the session laws. The joint printing committee
6 will prepare a brief written report of its recommendations, which written
7 report must be delivered to the judiciary and rules committees of the sen-
8 ate and the house of representatives. The written report must include the
9 projected cost to implement its recommendation, together with a distribu-
10 tion list of persons that will be provided printed volume(s) of the session
11 laws. If the written or amended report is rejected by the legislature by
12 concurrent resolution, the joint printing committee will meet to reconsider
13 its recommendations. If the written or amended report is not rejected, the
14 joint printing committee will enter into an agreement(s) that is substan-
15 tially consistent with its written or amended report to print, publish, and
16 deliver the session laws, which costs will be paid from the legislative ac-
17 count."

18 CORRECTION TO TITLE

19 On page 1, in line 2, delete "PUBLISHING" and insert: "PRINTING"; delete
20 lines 6 through 11, and insert: "REPORT OF THE JOINT PUBLISHING COMMITTEE;
21 AND AMENDING SECTION 67-509, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE JOINT PRINTING
22 COMMITTEE FOR THE PUBLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF SESSION LAWS AND TO PRO-
23 VIDE FOR A REPORT OF THE JOINT PRINTING COMMITTEE."
