- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- SECTION 1. That Section 31-704, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 31-704. COMMISSIONERS' DISTRICTS. (1) At the regular meeting in January, preceding any general election, the board of commissioners must district their county into three (3) districts, as nearly equal in population as may be, to be known as county commissioners' districts, numbers one (1), two (2) and three (3) respectively; provided, that when a new county shall have been created, or the boundary lines of a county shall have been changed, then the board of commissioners of such county may district their county at any general or special meeting of such board.
 - (2) Any person voting or offering to vote in any election for county commissioner must be, at the time of the election, eighteen (18) years of age and a United States citizen who has resided in this state and in the county at least thirty (30) days next preceding the election in which the elector desires to vote. In the case of election of commissioner, the elector must be a resident of the same commissioner district as the candidate or candidates for commissioner for whom the elector offers to vote at least thirty (30) days next preceding the election in which the elector desires to vote.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall be in full force and effect on and after January 1, 2019.
