A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE DI-VISION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO RULES OF BUILDING SAFETY, RULES GOVERNING SAFETY INSPECTIONS - GENERAL AND SAFETY AND HEALTH RULES FOR PLACES OF PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the Division of Building Safety relating to Rules of Building Safety, Rules Governing Safety Inspections - General and Safety and Health Rules for Places of Public Employment are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.03.01, relating to Rules of Building Safety, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 07-0301-1701, the entire rulemaking docket; IDAPA 07.04.01, relating to Rules Governing Safety Inspections - General, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 07-0401-1701, the entire rulemaking docket; and IDAPA 07.09.01, relating to Safety and Health Rules for Places of Public Employment, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 07-0901-1701, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same are hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
