SENATE BILL NO. 1347

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PRO-  
2 GRAM/DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019; PROVIDING FOR EX-  
3 PENDITURES TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION  
4 OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019; APPROPRIATING GENERAL FUND MON-  
5 EYS FOR TRANSFER TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND; APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
6 TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION OF ADMIN-  
7 ISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019; AND AMENDING SECTION 33-1004E, IDAHO  
8 CODE, TO INCREASE THE BASE SALARY FOR ADMINISTRATORS AND TO MAKE TECH-  
9 NICAL CORRECTIONS.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

12 SECTION 1. The following amount shall be expended for the Public  
13 Schools Educational Support Program/Division of Administrators for the pe-  
14 riod July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019:

17 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the following amount to be  
18 transferred to the Public School Income Fund for the period July 1, 2018,  
19 through June 30, 2019:

22 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Schools Educa-  
23 tional Support Program/Division of Administrators the following amount to  
24 be expended from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30,  
25 2019:

28 SECTION 4. That Section 33-1004E, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
29 amended to read as follows:

30 33-1004E. DISTRICT'S SALARY-BASED APPORTIONMENT. Each district shall  
31 be entitled to a salary-based apportionment calculated as provided in this  
32 section.

33 (1) To determine the apportionment for instructional staff, take  
34 the amounts indicated on the career ladder table plus the amounts associ-

1 ated with the additional education allocation amounts pursuant to section  
2 33-1004B, Idaho Code, and calculate the weighted average. The amount so  
3 determined shall be multiplied by the district staff allowance for instruc-  
4 tional staff determined as provided in section 33-1004(2), Idaho Code.  
5 Full-time instructional staff salaries shall be determined from a salary  
6 schedule developed by each district and submitted to the state department of  
7 education. No full-time instructional staff member shall be paid less than  
8 the minimum dollar amount on the career ladder residency compensation rung  
9 pursuant to section 33-1004B, Idaho Code, for the applicable fiscal year.

10 (2) If an instructional staff member has been certified by the national  
11 board for professional teaching standards, the staff member shall receive  
12 two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year for five (5) years from the year in  
13 which national board certification was earned. The district staff allot-  
14 ment shall be increased by two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each national  
15 board-certified instructional staff member who earned national board cer-  
16 tification; provided however, that no such awards shall be paid for the pe-  
17 riod July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, nor shall any liabilities accrue  
18 or payments be made pursuant to this section in the future to any individu-  
19 als who would have otherwise qualified for a payment during this stated time  
20 period. The resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment  
21 for instructional staff. For purposes of this section, teachers qualifying  
22 for the salary increase shall be those who have been recognized as national  
23 board-certified teachers as of July 1 of each year.

24 (3) To determine the apportionment for pupil service staff, take  
25 the amounts indicated on the career ladder table plus the amounts associ-  
26 ated with the additional education allocation amounts pursuant to section  
27 33-1004B, Idaho Code, and calculate the weighted average. If the district  
28 does not employ any pupil service staff, the district's pupil service staff  
29 average salary shall equal the district's instructional staff average  
30 salary for purposes of calculating pupil service salary-based apportion-  
31 ment. The amount so determined shall be multiplied by the district staff al-  
32 lowance for pupil service staff determined pursuant to section 33-1004(3),  
33 Idaho Code. Full-time pupil service staff salaries shall be determined from  
34 a salary schedule developed by each district and submitted to the state de-  
35 partment of education. The resulting amount is the district's salary-based  
36 apportionment for pupil service staff. No full-time pupil service staff  
37 member shall be paid less than the minimum dollar amount on the career ladder  
38 residency compensation rung pursuant to section 33-1004B, Idaho Code, for  
39 the applicable fiscal year.

40 (4) To determine the apportionment for district administrative staff,  
41 first determine the district average experience and education index by plac-  
42 ing all eligible certificated administrative employees on the statewide  
43 index provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is the  
44 district index. If the district does not employ any administrative staff,  
45 the district administrative index shall equal the statewide average index  
46 for purposes of calculating administrative salary-based apportionment.  
47 The district administrative staff index shall be multiplied by the base  
48 salary of ~~thirty-fivesix~~ thirty-two eighty-six thousand one hundred ~~thirty-two~~ eighty-six dol-  
49 lars (~~\$35,13236,186~~). The amount so determined shall be multiplied by the  
50 district staff allowance for administrative staff determined as provided

1 in section 33-1004(4), Idaho Code. The resulting amount is the district's  
2 salary-based apportionment for administrative staff.

3 (5) To determine the apportionment for classified staff, multiply  
4 twenty thousand four hundred twenty-one dollars (\$20,421) by the district  
5 classified staff allowance determined as provided in section 33-1004(5),  
6 Idaho Code. The amount so determined is the district's apportionment for  
7 classified staff.

8 (6) The district's salary-based apportionment shall be the sum of the  
9 apportionments calculated in subsections (1), (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this  
10 section, plus the benefit apportionment as provided in section 33-1004F,  
11 Idaho Code.
