A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DI-
3 VISION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO SAFETY AND HEALTH RULES FOR PLACES
4 OF PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 Division of Building Safety relating to Safety and Health Rules for Places of
12 Public Employment are not consistent with legislative intent and should be
13 rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular
15 Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of
16 Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.09.01, relating to Safety
17 and Health Rules for Places of Public Employment, adopted as a pending rule
18 under Docket Number 07-0901-1701, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the
19 same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
