2 ENDORSING THE LIMITATION OF PRINTING OF THE IDAHO SESSION LAWS TO A TOTAL OF
3 150 COPIES GIVEN THE ACCESSIBILITY AND DECREASE IN EXPENDITURES ASSOCI-
4 ATED WITH ONLINE ACCESS TO THE IDAHO SESSION LAWS.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, Section 67-904, Idaho Code, provides for the publication and
7 distribution of the Idaho Session Laws; and

8 WHEREAS, the Senate and the House of Representatives are working to im-
9 prove online access to past Idaho Session Laws; and

10 WHEREAS, the Joint Publishing Committee has considered the accessibil-
11 ity and decrease in expenditures associated with online access to the Idaho
12 Session Laws in its determination to preserve limited availability of physi-
13 cal copies of the Idaho Session Laws.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
15 sion of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-
16 resentatives concurring therein, that beginning with the First Regular Ses-
17 sion of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, given the accessibility and de-
18 crease in expenditures associated with online access to the Idaho Session
19 Laws, we endorse limiting printing of the Idaho Session Laws to a total of 150
20 copies to be distributed based on online requests for physical copies.
