FY 2020 STATE GENERAL FUND DISTRICT SUPPORT

\$ 1.24 million from Trustee & Benefits Fund

Each district receives:

- \$11,300 base & operating, capacity building funding
- Local matching funds - ~\$24,800 on average (*mean*) per District (\$11,187 - after 1% rescission - lowest allocation and 2 Districts capped @ \$50,000)
- \$10,000 distributed equally among 6 regions for outreach/ed
- No project funding

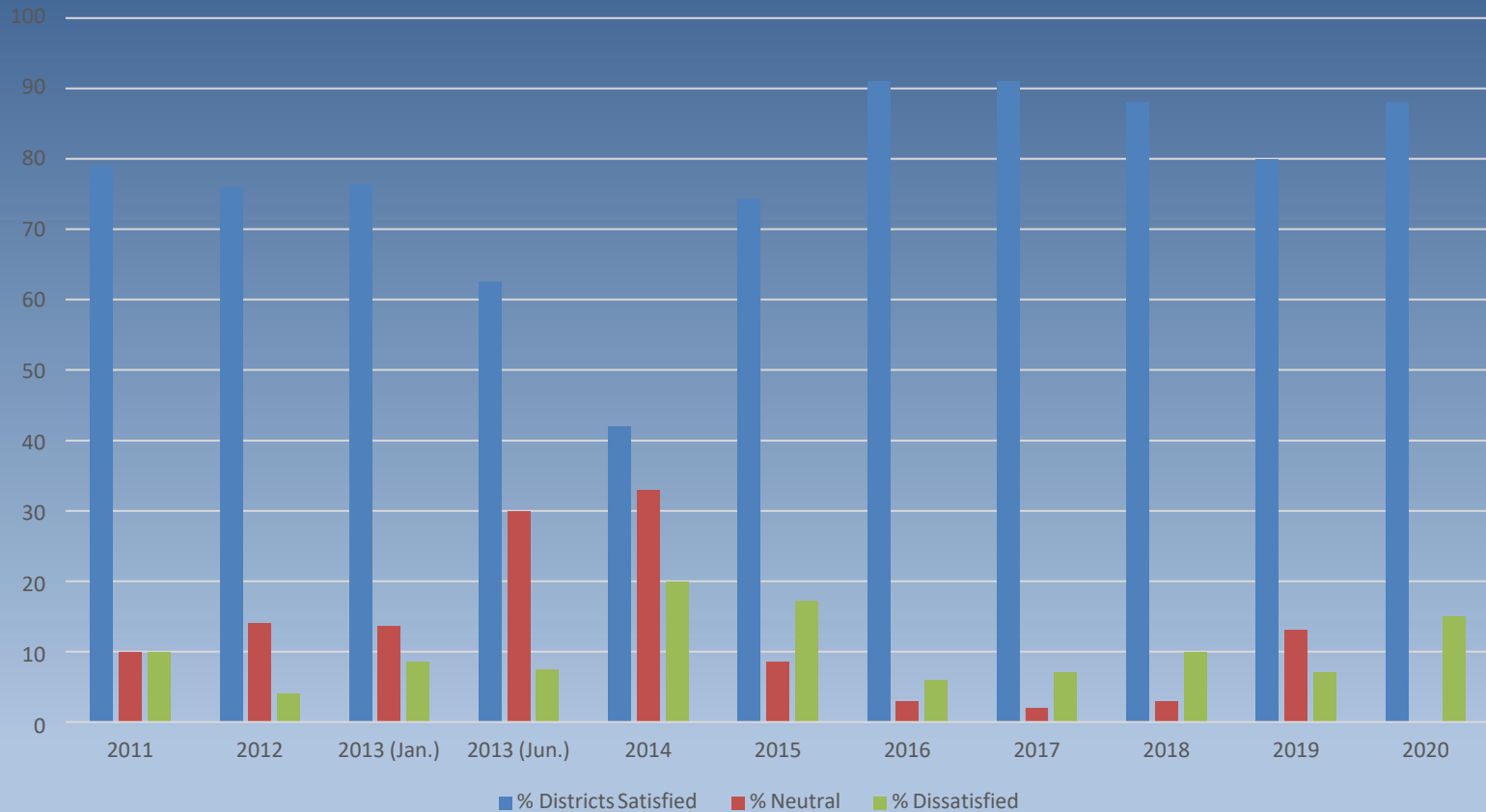
FY 2020 State Technical Assistance

- 436 landowners served

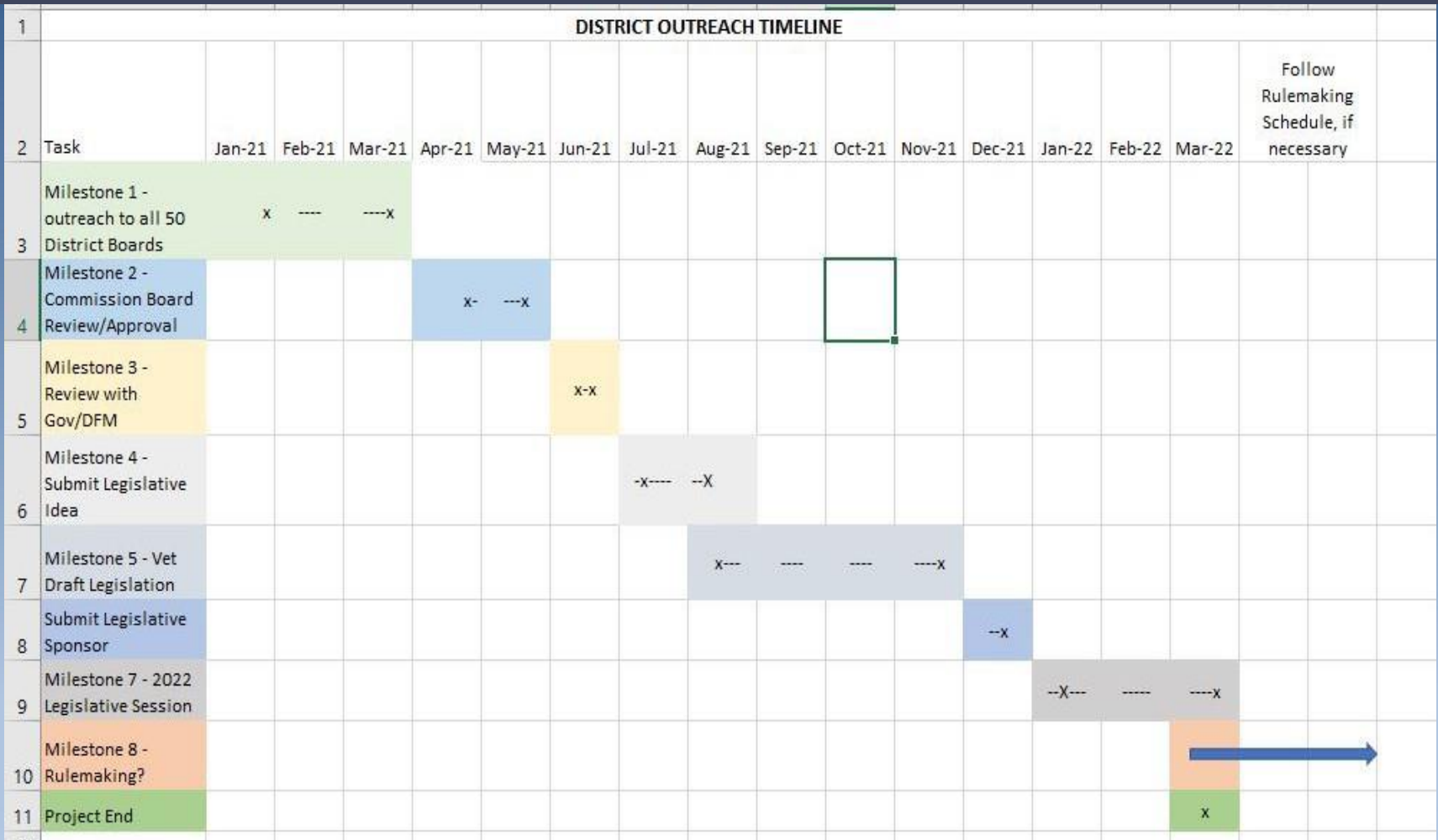
District Satisfaction Surveys, FY 2011-2020
