	Chairman Amador called the meeting to order at 1:43 p.m.
MOTION:	Rep. Necochea made a motion to approve the minutes of March 11, 2021, and March 16, 2021. Motion carried by voice vote .
RS 28860:	Rep. Horman presented RS 28860 , a proposed resolution honoring Eric Milstead , Director of the Legislative Services Office, for 23 years of service.
MOTION:	Rep. Rubel made a motion to introduce RS 28860. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 28843:	Rep. Palmer presented RS 28843 , proposed legislation allowing electronic vehicle credential providers to offer a convenience processing fee. It was noted this is an optional process.
MOTION:	Rep. Monks made a motion to introduce RS 28843. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 28878:	Rep. Palmer presented RS 28878 , proposed legislation establishing parity between electric vehicle fee or plug-in hybrid vehicles, and traditional vehicles registered in Idaho. This would allow electric vehicles to choose between a flat fee for registration and a per-mile charge. A committee member expressed concern regarding the formulation of the increased fee for electric vehicles.
MOTION:	Rep. Blanksma made a motion to introduce RS 28878. Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Rubel, Necochea and Toone requested to be recorded as voting NAY.
RS 28899:	Rep. Palmer presented RS 28899 , proposed legislation increasing sales tax distribution to transportation from 1% to 4.5%, dedicating eighty million dollars (\$80,000,000) of those funds annually to the Idaho Transportation Department for large infrastructure projects on the state highway system. Any excess funds are dedicated to local units of government for roads and bridges as sales tax revenues increase.
MOTION:	Rep. Monks made a motion to introduce RS 28899. Motion carried by voice vote.
ADJOURN:	There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 1:54 p.m.
