Chairman Amador called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
Rep. Vander Woude presented RS 28904 , proposed legislation ensuring uniform laws on the sale of tobacco products and electronic cigarettes across the state by preventing local authorities from implementing varying regulations more restrictive than state law.
Rep. Moyle made a motion to introduce RS 28904. Motion carried by voice vote Reps. Toone, Necochea, and Rubel requested they be recorded as voting NAY.
Speaker Bedke presented RS 28894 , proposed legislation authorizing an interim committee comprised of the membership of the House Environment, Energy & Technology and the Senate Local Government & Taxation standing committees to review the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for allowable broadband and sewer infrastructure projects.
Rep. Blanksma made a motion to introduce RS 28894 and recommend it be sent directly to the Second Reading Calendar. Motion carried by voice vote .
Speaker Bedke presented RS 28895 , proposed legislation authorizing an interim committee comprised of the membership of the House Resources and Conservation and the Senate Resources and Environment standing committees to review the use of ARPA funds for allowable water infrastructure projects.
Rep. Blanksma made a motion to introduce RS 28895 and recommend it be sent directly to the Second Reading Calendar. Motion carried by voice vote .
Speaker Bedke presented RS 28898 , proposed legislation authorizing an interim committee comprised of both Senate and House membership to review the use of ARPA funds for federal programs. Any necessary legislator travel expense or funding for staff support and expenses would be paid from the existing Covid Relief ARPA Funds.
Rep. Blanksma made a motion to introduce RS 28898 and recommend it be sent directly to the Second Reading Calendar. Motion carried by voice vote.
There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
