	Chairman Amador called the meeting to order at 12:03 p.m.
MOTION:	<b>Rep. Blanksma</b> made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 23, 2021, meeting. <b>Motion carried by voice vote.</b>
RS 28965:	<b>Rep. Moyle</b> presented <b>RS 28965</b> , proposed legislation providing property tax relief and limiting the ability of local taxing districts to increase their budgets.
MOTION:	Rep. Monks made a motion to introduce RS 28965. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 28957:	<b>Rep. Manwaring</b> presented <b>RS 28957</b> . This proposed legislation clarifies qualified payments made directly to households from the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) and used to pay rent or utilities is not taxable income.
MOTION:	Rep. Blanksma made a motion to introduce RS 28957. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 28966:	<b>Rep. Blanksma</b> presented <b>RS 28966</b> . This proposed legislation would recess the legislature and suspend per diem to a date to no later than September 1, 2021, subject to the call of the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
MOTION:	Rep. Monks made a motion to introduce RS 28966. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 28962, RS 28963C1, RS 28964:	<b>Rep. Monks</b> presented together <b>RS 28962, RS 28963C1, and RS 28964</b> , proposed legislation clarifying constitutional rights cannot be suspended because of a declared emergency, and the power and authority to create and amend laws is reserved to the legislature. During a declared emergency the executive branch cannot change laws, and identifies all jobs as essential.
MOTION:	Rep. Blanksma made a motion to introduce RS 28962, RS 28963C1, and RS 28964. Motion carried by voice vote. Reps. Toone, Necochea, and Rubel (Dittrich) requested to be recorded as voting NAY.
ADJOURN:	There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 12:14 p.m.
