



Agency Summary & Statutory Authority

The Wolf Depredation Control Board (WDCB) is a five-member board in the Office of the Governor that directs and manages funds for the purpose of wolf depredation control within the State of Idaho. It oversees investigation and lethal removal of problem wolves and administers ongoing General Fund appropriations as well as continuously appropriated funds sourced through fees from sportsmen and the livestock industry. The WDCB has a cooperative services agreement and a work plan with Wildlife Services (Section 22-5301, Idaho Code) to carry out lethal removals.

Fig 1. WDCB Revenues by Fiscal Year

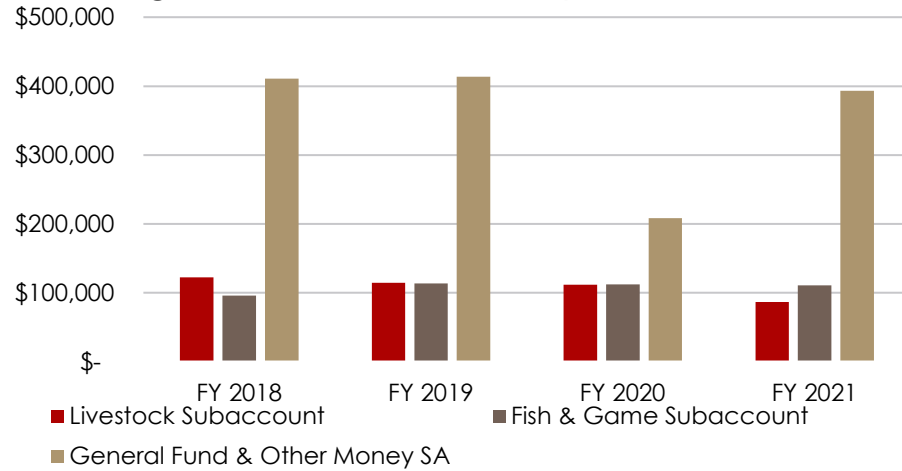


Fig 2. WDCB Expenditures by Fiscal Year

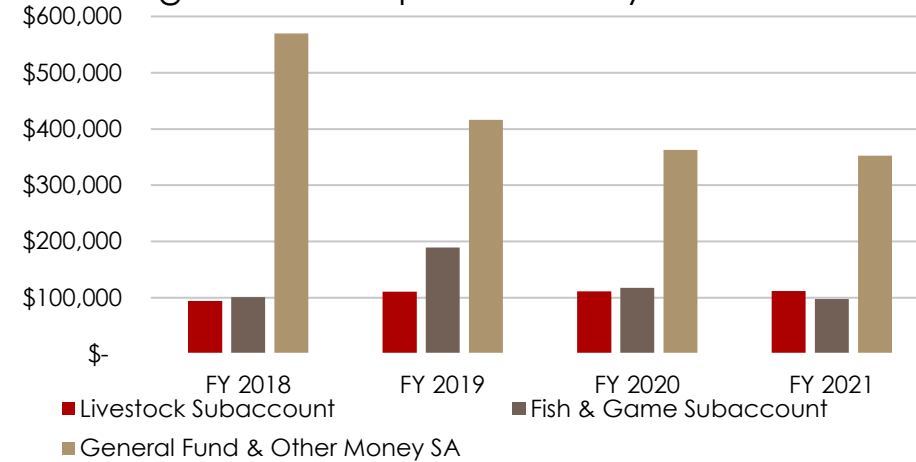


Fig 3. WDCB Dedicated Fund Balances by Fiscal Year

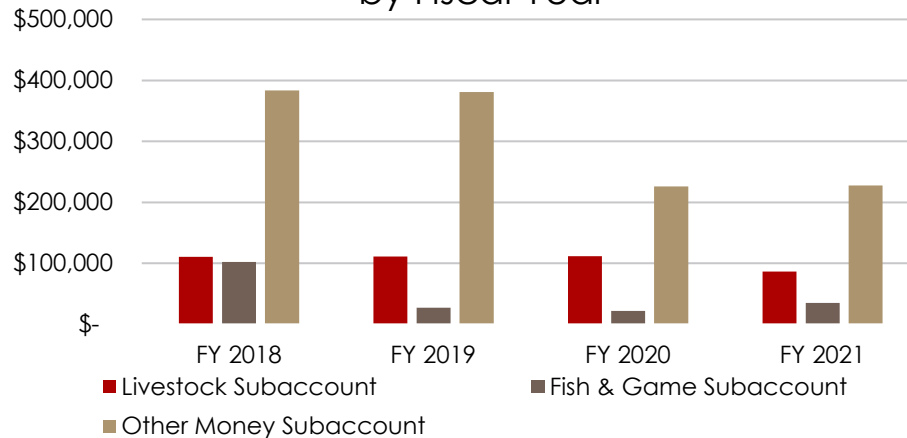
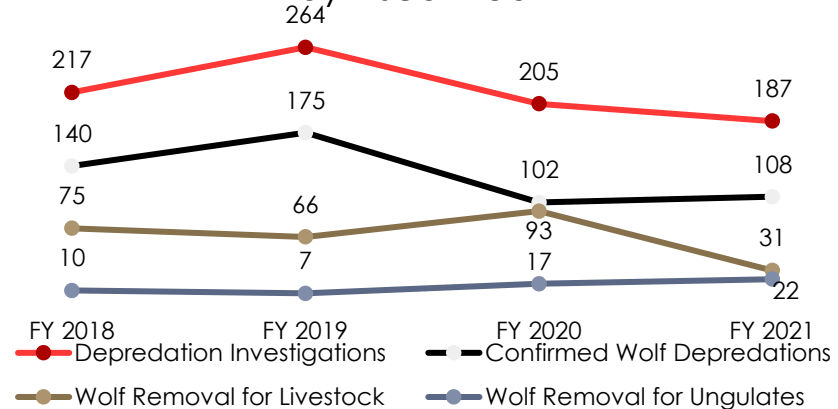


Fig 4. Wolf Investigations and Removals by Fiscal Year
