S 1236:	<b>Sen. Thayn</b> said <b>S 1236</b> relates to Health Savings Accounts for state employees. This legislation would make it easier for the Department of Administration to calculate the amount to be deposited in an employee's Health Savings Account.		
	In response to questions about whether this is a change from the past, <b>Sen. Thayr</b> said this is in preparation for the future and the intent is to ensure Health Savings Accounts receive as much funding as possible.		
MOTION:	<b>Rep. Harris</b> made a motion to send <b>S 1236</b> to the floor with a <b>DO PASS</b> recommendation. <b>Motion carried by voice vote</b> . <b>Rep. Clow</b> will sponsor the bill on the floor.		
S 1237:	<b>Mark Tschampl</b> , Chief Administrator, Idaho Division of Veterans Services, said <b>S 1237</b> clarifies how veterans preferences protections are implemented and the process by which appeals are settled. Additionally, this would authorize the Division of Human Resources instead of the Division of Veterans Services to create administrative rules regarding this because they have the required expertise.
