HOUSE BILL NO. 276

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

1 AN ACT  
2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO IDAHO PUBLIC TELEVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR  
3 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO IDAHO PUBLIC TELEVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR  
4 2024; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-  
5 TIONS; PROVIDING FOR A CONTINUOUS APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR REAP-  
6 PROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND DECLARING AN  
7 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Idaho Public Television the  
10 following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes  
11 from the General Fund for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024:

17 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,  
18 Idaho Code, Idaho Public Television is authorized no more than fourteen  
19 (14.00) full-time equivalent positions from the General Fund at any point  
20 during the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, unless specifically  
21 authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee  
22 will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

23 SECTION 3. CONTINUOUS APPROPRIATION. Idaho Public Television is hereby  
24 granted continuous appropriation authority for its Miscellaneous Revenue  
25 Fund for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, for the purpose of  
26 content production and related services from revenue sources provided by  
27 private donations.

28 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated  
29 to Idaho Public Television any unexpended and unencumbered balances appro-  
30 priated to Idaho Public Television from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund for  
31 fiscal year 2023 to be used for nonrecurring expenditures for the period July  
32 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The Office of the State Controller shall con-  
33 firm the reappropriation amount, by fund, expense class, and program, with  
34 the Legislative Services Office prior to processing the reappropriation au-  
35 thorized herein.

36 SECTION 5. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in  
37 statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may be

1 used only for that purpose. All funds provided in this act shall be subject  
2 to accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section  
3 67-702, Idaho Code.

4 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
6 July 1, 2023.
