HOUSE BILL NO. 355

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION FROM THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM INCOME FUND FOR FIS-  
2 CAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WEL-  
3 FARE FOR THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT AND PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR FIS-  
4 CAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE TREASURER FOR DISTRI-  
5 BUTION TO RECOVERY IDAHO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO  
6 THE PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS  
7 TO IDAHO PUBLIC TELEVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS  
8 TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE STUDENT SERVICES PROGRAM  
9 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 EDUCATION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; CLARI-  
11 FYING THE USE OF FUNDS; REQUIRING REPORTING ON THE COMPREHENSIVE STATE  
12 PLAN; PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION ON THE USE OF THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM IN-  
13 COME FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and  
17 Welfare for the Substance Abuse Treatment and Prevention Program \$160,000  
18 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to be expended for the period July 1,  
19 2023, through June 30, 2024, for the purpose of performing tobacco and vape  
20 compliance checks.

21 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Treasurer  
22 \$1,350,000 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to be expended for the pe-  
23 riod July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, to be provided to Recovery Idaho  
24 for equal distribution to the nine recovery centers for the purpose of opera-  
25 tional support.

26 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Health Districts  
27 \$499,800 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to be expended for the period  
28 July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, to be equally distributed among the Pub-  
29 lic Health Districts and expended for tobacco and vaping prevention and ces-  
30 sation programs.

31 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to Idaho Public Television  
32 \$300,000 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to be expended for the period  
33 July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, for the purpose of production and media  
34 campaigns for education and awareness related to vaping and tobacco.

35 SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Edu-  
36 cation for the Student Services Program \$3,000,000 from the Idaho Millennium  
37 Income Fund to be expended for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024,  
38 for the purpose of safe and drug free related programs and overall health and  
39 wellbeing of Idaho youth in schools.

1 SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Edu-  
2 cation for the Administration Program \$250,000 from the Idaho Millennium In-  
3 come Fund to be expended for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024,  
4 for the purpose of developing a comprehensive state plan on youth preven-  
5 tion programs for tobacco and vape products and the overall health of Idaho's  
6 youth.

7 SECTION 7. SAFE AND DRUG FREE SCHOOL PROGRAMS. Of the moneys appropri-  
8 ated in Section 5 of this act, funds are to be maximized through enhancements  
9 of existing programs, establishing new programs not being provided by other  
10 government entities, and with collaboration from the members of the Joint  
11 Legislative Millennium Fund Committee.

12 SECTION 8. COMPREHENSIVE STATE PLAN. Of the moneys appropriated in  
13 Section 6 of this act, the comprehensive state plan must involve input from  
14 other state, local, and nonprofit entities to achieve comprehensiveness for  
15 the most effective and efficient results. The State Department of Education  
16 shall on a periodic basis report to the Joint Legislative Millennium Fund  
17 Committee on progress with implementation of the comprehensive state plan.

18 SECTION 9. FUTURE CONSIDERATION FOR USE OF FUNDS. The Joint Legisla-  
19 tive Millennium Fund Committee, pursuant to Section 67-1808(6), Idaho Code,  
20 recommends that all moneys available for appropriation from the Idaho Mil-  
21 lennium Income Fund beginning in fiscal year 2024 and each year thereafter,  
22 be prioritized for programs that focus on prevention, cessation, and treat-  
23 ment related to tobacco, vaping, alcohol, illegal substances, and other  
24 substances that may be abused beyond the intended uses, and for the over-  
25 all safety and well-being of Idaho youth. Funding should be prioritized  
26 to programs first that benefit Idahoans less than 18 years of age and then  
27 for adults with higher risk factors for abusing or using various substances  
28 outlined in this section. Consistent with Section 67-1806, Idaho Code, the  
29 joint committee shall be responsible for the predominant recommendation  
30 on the uses of the Idaho Millennium Income Fund. In accordance with the  
31 priorities of this section, any requested funds not already an ongoing ap-  
32 propriation in fiscal year 2024 shall be presented in the Legislative Budget  
33 Book as a request for new onetime appropriation in the Idaho Millennium Fund  
34 Program and not in the respective agency budgets.

35 SECTION 10. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
36 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
37 July 1, 2023.
