2 RELATING TO TORT CLAIMS AGAINST GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES; AMENDING SECTION  
3 6-906A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR A TIME FOR FILING CLAIMS BY A MINOR IN  
4 A CHILD ABUSE CASE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFEC-  
5 TIVE DATE.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 6-906A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 6-906A. TIME FOR FILING CLAIMS BY MINORS. ~~No~~ (1) Except as provided in  
10 subsection (2) of this section, no person who is a minor shall be required to  
11 present and file a claim against a governmental entity or its employee under  
12 this chapter until one hundred eighty (180) days after said person reaches  
13 the age of majority or six (6) years from the date the claim arose or should  
14 reasonably have been discovered, whichever is earlier.

15 (2) For any claim filed by or on behalf of a minor against a governmental  
16 entity or its employee in a child abuse case, as described in section 6-1701,  
17 Idaho Code, such claim shall be filed in accordance with the provisions of  
18 section 6-1704, Idaho Code.

19 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
21 July 1, 2023.
