  - o Produce 10% of the nation's Real Sugar





#### Nampa Anaerobic Digester

#### From Bugs to Biogas to Energy

- Microorganisms reduce organic strength of wastewater
- Converts into Biogas
- Biogas will be used to generate electricity (2 Megawatt)
- Treated and clarified water is recycled or discharged into the City of Nampa







### Mini-Cassia Steam Dryer (Beet Pulp)

# +20% reduction of fuel consumption and emissions (>40,000 metric tons of CO2)

- ~\$50 million Earnings Capital spend
- Eliminates two existing pulp dryers that burn natural gas and/or coal
- Will be powered by steam from the existing boiler house, resulting in nearly 100% energy savings
- Steam significantly reduces product loss
- Could qualify for federal tax credit

## **Youth Grower Projects**

## 2023 - 170 youth, ages 8 to 18

- 1 Share (1 acre) provided by the Cooperative
- \$2,950 gross revenue for the 1 acre
- \$501,615 contributed to youth through the Youth Grower Project
