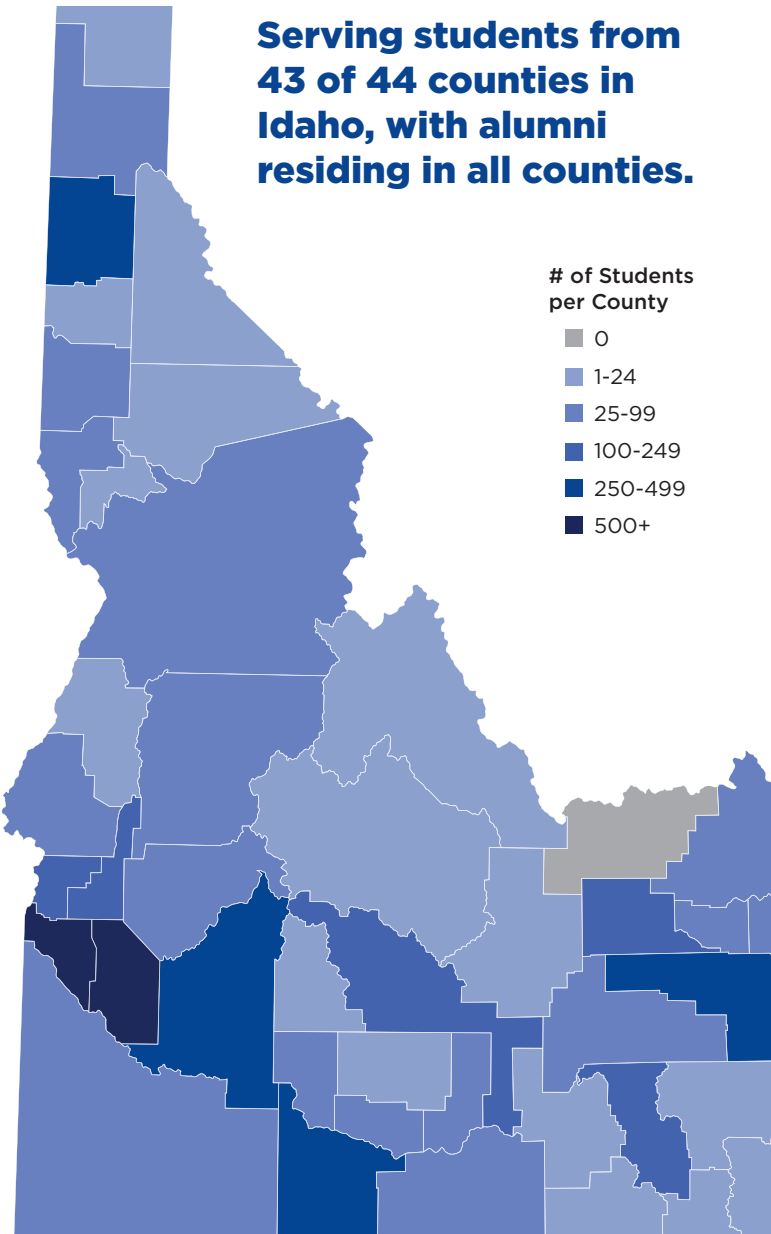

Economic Impact

\$1.6 billion economic impact supported 27,834 Idaho jobs

Tax Benefits

Idaho taxpayer benefits generated by graduates.

For every \$1 of public funds invested in Boise State, taxpayers receive a **cumulative return of 2.5 times** that amount over the course of a student's working life.

MOST EFFICIENT IN IDAHO

Boise State eliminated a \$15 million structural deficit and **balanced its budget.**

Boise State has the **lowest administrative to instructional cost** in the state. For every \$1 spent on instruction, Boise State spends only .18 cents on administration, well below the national average of .25 cents.
