<u>S 1376</u>	PUBLIC OFFICIALS - Amends existing law to provide an exception for certain public officials for the use of public property or resources while advocating for or against an initiative or referendum.	Senator Okuniewicz
<u>S 1377</u>	BALLOT MEASURES - Amends existing law to require paid signature gatherers to disclose that they are being paid and to revise provisions regarding the collection of signatures for ballot measures.	Senator Okuniewicz
<u>H 456</u>	STATE CONTROLLER - Amends existing law to remove a provision regarding digital copies of agreements entered into by state officers and agencies and to authorize the State Controller to develop a policy regarding agreements.	Representative Scott
