AN ACT

1 RELATING TO MORTICIANS; AMENDING SECTION 54-1112, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE LI-
2 CENSE ELIGIBILITY PROVISIONS FOR RESIDENT TRAINEES AND TO PROVIDE THAT
3 A SPECIFIED TIME LIMITATION INCLUDES ALL TIME PRACTICING AS A RESIDENT
4 TRAINEE OR APPRENTICE FOR A MORTICIAN LICENSE, FUNERAL DIRECTOR LI-
5 CENSE, OR BOTH.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 54-1112, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 54-1112. REQUIREMENTS FOR RESIDENT TRAINEE LICENSE. The board shall
11 issue to any person a resident trainee license to practice as a resident
12 trainee and perform services at a particular establishment under the per-
13 sonal supervision of a specified licensed mortician within the state of
14 Idaho who has complied with and fulfilled all of the following requirements:

15 (1) Has attained the age of eighteen (18) years, and is a resident of the
16 state of Idaho.

17 (2) Is of good moral character.

18 (3) Has graduated from an accredited high school or has received an
19 equivalent education as determined by the standards set and established by
20 the state board of education.

21 (4) Has filed an application with the board as required by this chap-
22 ter and paid the required filing fee. Provided further, that the board shall
23 make the determination of qualifications of all applicants within a reason-
24 able time after the filing of an application with the board. Provided fur-
25 ther, no person shall be eligible to be licensed as a resident trainee ~~who has~~
26 ~~practiced as a resident trainee or apprentice~~ for a total cumulative period
27 of more than ~~two~~ three (23) years in the state of Idaho unless approved by the
28 board for good cause. The three (3) year limitation includes all time prac-
29 ticing as a resident trainee or apprentice for a mortician license, funeral
30 director license, or both.
