STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS24128

This legislation provides for the issuance of driving privilege card to those who have not been assigned a social security number. With certain limitations, the driving privilege card would be equivalent to a class D driver's license or class D instruction permit. The driving privilege card must clearly display that it is 'FOR DRIVING PRIVILEGES ONLY – NOT VALID FOR IDENTIFICATION" and it may not be accepted as proof of personal identification by a governmental entity. Driving privilege cards shall expire each year on the birth date of the applicant.

FISCAL NOTE

Applicants for driving privilege cards will pay the same fees as those applying for a class D driver's license, so the fiscal impact, if any, will be the same as for class D driver's licenses.
