2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE DE-
3 PARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING CAPITOL MALL
4 PARKING.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 Department of Administration relating to Rules Governing Capitol Mall Park-
12 ing are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
14 sion of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-
15 sentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 38.04.04, Rules of the Department
16 of Administration, Rules Governing Capitol Mall Parking, Section 022., Sub-
17 sections 02.b. and 08.d., and Section 040., Subsections 02.g. and 02.h.,
18 only, adopted as pending rules under Docket Number 38-0404-1501, be, and the
19 same are hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
