

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS25570

This bill appropriates, distributes, and transfers a total of \$9,136,200 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund for fiscal year 2018 to the listed beneficiaries; requires a signed agreement from non-state entities, in order to receive grant funds; provides that certain unexpended and unencumbered balance of moneys shall revert to the Idaho Millennium Income Fund at the end of fiscal year 2018; and provides that any remaining unexpended and unencumbered balance of moneys in the Idaho Millennium Income Fund shall be transferred to the Idaho Millennium Permanent Endowment Fund at the end of fiscal year 2018. Of the total \$6,444,700 is for state agencies and \$2,691,500 is for non-state entities. Further, funding for the Department of Health and Welfare's Project Filter, and the Public Health Districts' Tobacco Cessation Programs are appropriated as ongoing.
