

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS25010

This bill provides a supplemental appropriation to the Public Defense Commission for FY 2017. Specifically, it provides for a net-zero General Fund object transfer of \$100,000 from trustee and benefit payments to operating expenditures so the commission can contract with Boise State University to conduct a public defender workload study. The study's purpose is to inform the commission's promulgation of administrative rules establishing public defender workload standards, as required by Sections 19-850(1)(a)(vi) and (vii)(3), Idaho Code. The object transfer is one-time for FY 2017, and amounts originally appropriated for trustee and benefit payments will be restored for FY 2018.
