RS 24971:	Jon Krutz, Stop Predatory Gambling Idaho, presented RS 24971, proposed legislation that removes the potential ambiguity within Title 67, Chapter 74, Idaho Code regarding TouchTabs Lottery machines and will require the Idaho State Lottery to cease operating them. He stated there is minimal fiscal impact because the TouchTabs machines are more expensive to acquire and operate than traditional lottery products, and any reduction in lottery expenses could increase total revenution schools and the Permanent Building Fund.
	In response to committee questions. Mr. Krutz stated the social cost is high for these types of machines.
