It allows for their access to emergency sites to either take care of their transmitters and/or inform the public through their stations about the emergency and what the public can do.
	<b>Rep. Erpelding</b> raised concerns about the legislative process and the fact that the same bill is in General Orders.

RS 25519:	<b>Emily McClure</b> , Idaho Charter School Network, presented <b>RS 25519</b> . The proposed legislation streamlines the process of opening new charter schools without diminishing the level of scrutiny that the charter school petitioners need to demonstrate.
	<b>Rep. Erpelding</b> raised concerns about the legislative process and the fact that the same bill is in General Orders.
