Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

- SECTION 1. That Chapter 5, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-524, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
- 33-524. TRAINING FOR TRUSTEES. (1) For purposes of this section, "board member" means a person serving on a board of school district trustees or a board of directors for a public charter school.
- (2) Each board member shall, within one hundred eighty (180) days of election or appointment, undergo training on the duties of a board member. The training shall be provided by the state board of education or the state board's designee. Time constraints of the board members shall be taken into consideration when such training is developed and delivered.
- (3) Each board member shall undergo biennial training on fundamentals of board governance, issues of current concern in public education, and leading innovation and change in public education. The training shall be provided by the state board of education or the state board's designee.
- (4) The state board of education or its designee shall offer optional training to persons interested in serving as board members. The training shall be available electronically and include duties of a board member and issues of current concern in public education.
