6	TION OF A NEW SECTION 31-1414A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR ELECTIONS FOR
7	DIVISION OF A DISTRICT.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 14, Title 31, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 31-1413A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 31-1413A. DIVISION OF DISTRICT -- HEARING -- PROTEST -- ELECTION. Any fire protection district may be divided into two (2) fire protection districts subject to the following procedure, or pursuant to an election for division as provided in section 31-1414A, Idaho Code, and with the following effects:
- (1) If, in the opinion of the board of any fire protection district, it would be to the advantage of the district to be divided into two (2) fire protection districts, the board shall cause to be prepared and approved a resolution for division that shall, among other things, provide:
 - (a) The names of the proposed divided fire protection districts and their respective boundaries, along with identification of subdistricts;
 - (b) That fifty percent (50%), or the value thereof, or such other percentage as determined by the board of all assets of the district to be divided shall become the assets of each of the districts;
 - (c) That fifty percent (50%) of all debts of the district to be divided, or such other percentage as determined by the board, shall become the debts of each of the districts;
 - (d) That the existing commissioners of the district to be divided shall remain commissioners of the divided district in which they reside until the next election to be held pursuant to the terms of section 31-1410, Idaho Code, at which time three (3) additional commissioners shall be elected to fill vacancies created by the division, conditioned on their residency in one (1) of the districts, unless the resolution of division establishes a five (5) member board, in which case five (5) commissioners shall be elected. If each board consists of three (3) members, commissioners from fire protection subdistricts one and two in each district shall be elected for terms of four (4) years, and the commissioner from fire protection subdistrict three in each district shall be elected for a term of two (2) years. If each board consists of five (5) commissioners, the commissioners from fire protection subdistricts

- one, three, and five in each district shall be elected for terms of four (4) years, and the commissioners from fire protection subdistricts two and four in each district shall be elected for an initial term of two (2) years. Thereafter, the term of all commissioners in each district shall be four (4) years; and
- (e) That the employees of the divided fire protection districts shall be selected from the employees of the fire protection district being divided, which employees shall retain the seniority rights under their existing employment contracts. Any paid full-time firefighter of the fire protection district being divided shall be offered employment as a paid full-time firefighter from one (1) or both of the newly created fire protection districts, provided staffing needs of the districts are such to accommodate all current full-time firefighters before any additional paid full-time firefighters are offered employment. Additional staff and administrative employees may also be hired.
- (2) After approval of the resolution of division, the board of commissioners of the fire protection district shall hold a hearing no fewer than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) days thereafter and shall cause notice of the hearing designating the time and place to be published in at least one (1) issue of a newspaper of general circulation within the district no fewer than five (5) days prior to the hearing. Any person supporting or objecting to the division shall be heard at the hearing, if in attendance, and at the close of the hearing the board shall confirm approval or rejection of division. If the board confirms approval of the division, the division of the district shall be completed thirty (30) days after confirmation of the division unless, within the thirty (30) days, a petition signed by twenty-five percent (25%) of the qualified electors of the original fire protection district objecting to the division is filed with the secretary of the district. In the event of an objection, an election shall be held as provided in section 31-1405, Idaho Code, except that the question shall be "division of fire protection district, yes," or "division of fire protection district, no," or words equivalent thereto. If more than one-half (1/2) of the votes cast are yes, the division shall become effective. If more than onehalf (1/2) of the votes cast are no, the division shall be void and of no effect, and no new division shall be proposed for at least six (6) months following the date of the division election.
- (3) Upon the division becoming effective, the boards of the divided fire protection districts shall file a certified copy of the resolution of division with the county recorder of each county in which such districts are situated and shall comply with the provisions of section 63-215, Idaho Code. The divided districts shall thereafter have the same rights and obligations as any other fire protection district organized pursuant to this chapter.
- SECTION 2. That Chapter 14, Title 31, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 31-1414A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
- 31-1414A. ELECTION FOR THE DIVISION OF A DISTRICT. Upon a petition signed by ten percent (10%) or more of the electors in the last general election residing in a fire protection district, an election shall be conducted in the manner provided in section 31-1405, Idaho Code, at which the following

question shall be submitted to the electorate: "Shall fire protection district be divided into two (2) districts?" or words equivalent thereto. 1 2 At least one (1) public hearing shall be held by the board of fire district 3 commissioners prior to the election. If a majority of the votes cast in the 4 district proposed for division are in favor of division, the district shall 5 be deemed divided and a resolution of division in conformity with the pro-6 visions of section 31-1413A, Idaho Code, shall be entered into by the fire protection district board, except that a resolution of division entered into 8 pursuant to an election as provided in this section shall not thereafter be 9 subject to an election upon objection as provided in section 31-1413A(2), 10 11 Idaho Code.
