S 1249:	<b>Sen. Rice</b> This bill corrects an error in last year's <b>H 389</b> so that expiring Urban Renewal Districts come into local property tax budgets at eighty percent not subject to the eight percent cap. It also closes an unintended loophole regarding the use of forgone balances in property tax budgets.
	A committee member asked how this change will impact property taxes. <b>Sen. Rice</b> answered that actually it reduced the rate at which property taxes were going up.
MOTION:	<b>Rep. Shepherd</b> made a motion to send <b>S 1249</b> to the floor with a <b>DO PASS</b> recommendation. <b>Motion carried by a voice vote. Rep. Moyle</b> will sponsor the bill on the floor.
