H 642:	Rep. Troy said H 642 amends and repeals existing law to revise provisions regarding the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and to revise provisions regarding supervisors. H 642 changes how the commission is appointed, gives term limits, and removes the ability for more districts to be formed. In response to committee questions, Steve Becker , President, Association of Idaho Soil and Water Conservation Districts; Chairman, Nez Percé Soil and Water Conservation District, said the association represents all districts. He explained the difference between a supervisor and a commissioner, saying the supervisor is elected and serves a four year term, and commissioners are selected by the Governor and shall serve five years.		
MOTION:	Rep. Brooks made a motion to send H 642 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Troy will sponsor the bill on the floor.
