SENATE BILL NO. 1203

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
2 HEALTH AND WELFARE FOR THE DIVISION OF WELFARE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; AP-
3 PROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE
4 FOR THE DIVISION OF WELFARE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING ADDI-
5 TIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; PROVIDING
6 FOR THE USE OF FUNDS; DIRECTING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS; AND DECLARING
7 AN EMERGENCY.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
11 the appropriation made to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Divi-
12 sion of Welfare in Section 1, Chapter 190, Laws of 2022, from the Cooperative
13 Welfare (Federal) Fund is hereby reduced by \$14,394,000 for trustee and ben-
14 efit payments for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

15 SECTION 2. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
16 ter 190, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
17 hereby appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare for the Division
18 of Welfare \$28,025,000 from the Cooperative Welfare (Federal) Fund to be ex-
19 pended for operating expenditures for the period July 1, 2022, through June
20 30, 2023.

21 SECTION 3. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
22 ter 188, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
23 hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor for the Administrative Ser-
24 vices Program the following amounts to be expended from the Miscellaneous
25 Revenue Fund to be expended for the designated expense classes for the period
26 July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023:

31 SECTION 4. DIRECTING USE OF FUNDS. Of the amount appropriated in Sec-
32 tion 2 of this act, the Department of Health and Welfare shall subgrant the
33 entire amount to the Department of Labor to be used for child care grants
34 to eligible providers for provider grants, wage enhancements, and eligible
35 community partner providers pursuant to Section 6 of House Bill No. 764 as
36 enacted by the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature.

1 SECTION 5. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Department of Labor shall fol-
2 low all applicable guidance from the Department of Health and Welfare to en-
3 sure correct reporting on any grants distributed with moneys appropriated in
4 Section 3 of this act.

5 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
7 passage and approval.
