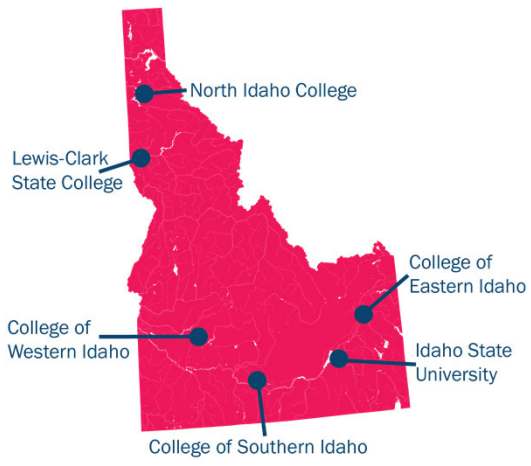

# Technical College System Success

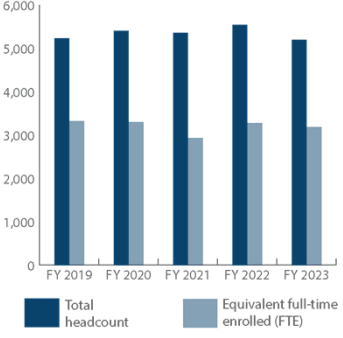

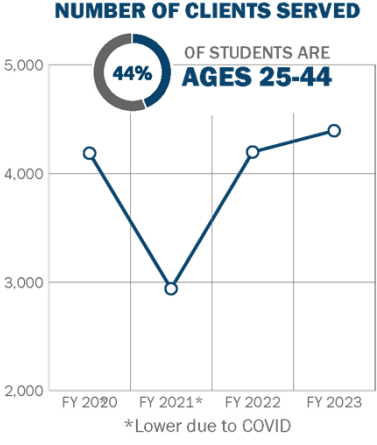

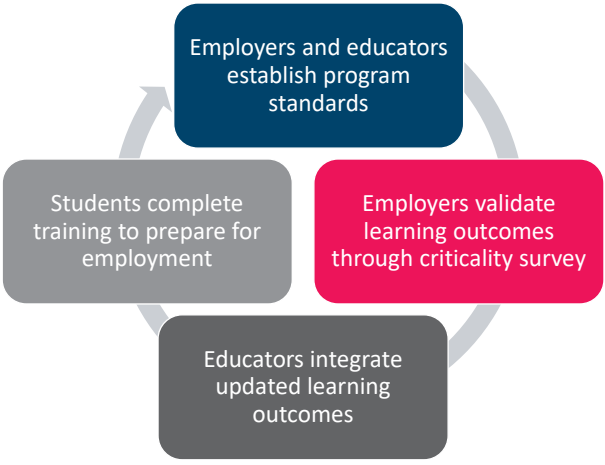

## Annual CTE Certification Trends

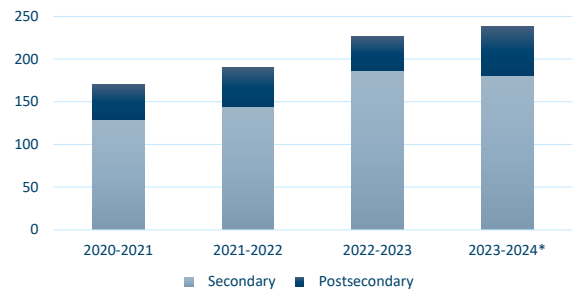


\*2023-2024 school year projected based on historical trends

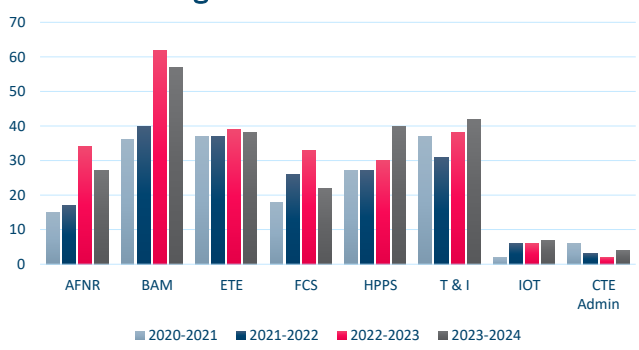


## CTE Certification Trends

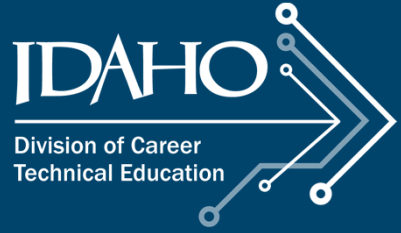
