CONVENED: **Chairman Lent** called the meeting of the Senate Education Committee (Committee) to order at 3:01 p.m.
PRESENTATION: **Lupine Flats: Affordable Housing Education and Community Partnership.** **Dr. Shauna Corry**, Dean, College of Art and Architecture, University of Idaho, provided an overview of the Lupine Flats Project. She spoke about its genesis and its cooperation with the Moscow Affordable Housing Trust. **Dr. Corry** introduced Jim Severt, Master of Architecture graduate student, University of Idaho, and Dr. Randall Teal, Architecture Department Chair, University of Idaho, who appeared virtually. **Mr. Severt** shared his experience on the student team. He described learning through planning, design, material procurement, permitting, and all aspects of construction.
