any other government agency receiving federal funds.

RS 28946: Rep. Harris presented RS 28946, proposed legislation reducing all income tax

brackets and setting the top individual and corporate tax bracket to 6.5% retroactive to January 1, 2021. This provides Idahoans with \$169.4 million in ongoing tax relief and provides a one-time sales tax/income tax rebate, returning \$220 million to Idaho taxpayers. A rebate check will be sent to 2020 personal income tax filers providing a minimum amount of \$50 for each taxpayer and dependent or 9% of

income taxes paid in 2019, whichever is greater.
