






FY 2023 Original Appropriation

In FY 2023, Idaho Public Television received continuous appropriation authority for its dedicated funding and associated FTP; this authority requires approval by the Legislature annually. The remaining funding is from the General Fund and is primarily used for operations, Idaho in session, and public safety partnerships with the Idaho Military Division. For FY 2023, IPTV also received an appropriation in S1395 for \$310,000 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to produce vaping awareness content.

Executive Carry Forward

Idaho Public Television was approved by the Division of Financial Management for \$233,500 in onetime Executive Carry Forward; this amount will be removed before calculating the base. This funding was encumbered by the agency for the purchase of an \$80,000 snowcat machine, and \$153,500 for various equipment to monitor and troubleshoot the broadcast stream. Funds were encumbered to allow for delivery of these items before payment.
