- RELATING TO THE STATE LOTTERY; AMENDING SECTION 67-7434, IDAHO CODE,
 TO REVISE DISTRIBUTION OF LOTTERY DIVIDENDS FOR A TWO YEAR
 PERIOD AND TO DELETE OBSOLETE LANGUAGE.
- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-7434, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to 7 read as follows:

67-7434. LOTTERY DIVIDENDS. (1) Annually, on July 1, 2009 through June 30, 8 2011, the lottery shall transfer one-half (1/2) of its net income to the permanent building 9 account fund and one-half (1/2) of its net income to the school district building account, after 10 reserving each of the several school districts, in the proportion that the average daily attendance 11 of that district for the previous school year bears to the total average daily attendance of the 12 state during the previous school year. School districts may utilize these moneys for any lawful 13 purpose of the district. For the purposes of this subsection (1) only, the Idaho school for the 14 deaf and the blind shall be considered a school district, and shall receive a distribution based 15 upon the average daily attendance of the school. Average daily attendance shall be calculated 16 as provided in section 33-1002(3), Idaho Code. Ssufficient reserve moneys shall be retained to 17 ensure the continuation of the lottery, as determined by the director and commission. 18 A one (1) time allotment of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) of the lottery's first 19 year dividends shall be allocated and used by the permanent building fund advisory council for 20 the construction of a Vietnam veterans memorial in the state. 21 (2) On and after July 1, 2011, annually, on July 1, the lottery shall transfer one-half (1/2)22

of its net income to the permanent building fund and one-half (1/2) of its net income to the school district building account, after reserving sufficient moneys to ensure the continuation of the lottery, as determined by the director and commission.
