RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES AND PASSENGER SAFETY FOR CHILDREN; AMENDING SECTION 49-672, IDAHO CODE, TO DELETE EXEMPTIONS.

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

5 SECTION 1. That Section 49-672, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to 6 read as follows:

49-672. PASSENGER SAFETY FOR CHILDREN. (1) No noncommercial motor
vehicle operator shall transport a child who is six (6) years of age or younger in a motor
vehicle manufactured with seat belts after January 1, 1966, unless the child is properly secured
in a child safety restraint that meets the requirements of federal motor vehicle safety standard
no. 213.

(2) The provisions of this section shall not apply:

13 (a) If all of the motor vehicle's seat belts are in use, but in such an event any
14 unrestrained child to which this section applies shall be placed in the rear seat of the
15 motor vehicle, if it is so equipped; or

16 (b) When the child is removed from the car safety restraint and held by the attendant

for the purpose of nursing the child or attending the child's other immediate physiological
needs.

19 (3) The failure to use a child safety restraint shall not be considered under any 20 circumstances as evidence of contributory negligence, nor shall such failure be admissible as 21 evidence in any civil action with regard to negligence.
