AMENDING CHAPTER 37, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-3726, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE COUNCIL OF IDAHO COLLEGE

AND UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 33-102, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

33-102. MEMBERSHIP -- APPOINTMENT -- TERM OF OFFICE -- QUALIFICATIONS -- PLACE OF OFFICE. The state board of education shall consist of the state superintendent of public instruction, who shall be an ex officio voting member and who shall serve as executive secretary of the board for all elementary and secondary school matters, and seven (7) members appointed by the governor, each for a term of five (5) years. Annually on the first day of March the governor shall appoint members to fill the board positions for which the terms of office have expired. The governor shall, by appointment, fill any vacancy on the board, such appointment to be for the unexpired term of the retiring member. Appointment to the board shall be made solely upon consideration of the ability of such appointees efficiently to serve the interests of the people, and education, without reference to locality, occupation, party affiliation or religion. Any person appointed to said board shall have been a resident of the state for not less than three (3) years prior to the date of appointment; and shall qualify and assume the duties in accordance with laws governing similar appointments to, and qualifications for, office on other state boards. All appointments of members to the state board of education made after the effective date of this act must be confirmed by the senate. The executive director of the council of Idaho college and university presidents shall serve as an ex officio voting member of the state board.

Members of the state board of education holding office on the effective date of this act shall continue in office for the balance of the term to which they were appointed.

The state board shall have and maintain its office in Ada county.

SECTION 2. That Chapter 37, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-3726, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-3726. COUNCIL OF IDAHO COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTS. (1) There is hereby created in the office of the governor the council of Idaho

college and university presidents. The council shall be composed of the presidents of Idaho's public baccalaureate degree granting institutions.

- (2) The council shall report to the governor and to the legislature, but shall not report to the state board of education.
- (3) The initial president of the council shall be the Idaho college or university president with the greatest seniority in that position. The president of the council shall serve a term of three (3) years. The order of succession after the initial president shall be in order of seniority as president of an Idaho college or university. In the event that a currently serving president of the council no longer serves as a president of an Idaho public institution of higher education, the successor shall be the Idaho college or university president with the next greatest seniority who will begin service as president of the council for a three (3) year term. No individual shall serve a second term as president of the council until all members of the council have had the opportunity to serve as the council's president.
- (4) The council shall meet not less than four (4) times per year at a location to be determined by the council. A majority of the membership of the council constitutes a quorum to transact business. Service on the council shall be part of the official duties of the Idaho college and university presidents.
- (5) The council shall appoint an executive director who shall serve at the pleasure of the council. The executive director shall be compensated as determined by the council. The executive director may appoint an administrative assistant who shall be subject to the provisions of chapter 53, title 67, Idaho Code. The office of the executive director shall be located in Ada county and the cost of operating that office shall be shared equally by the Idaho colleges and universities represented on the council.
- (6) The purpose of the council is to create an agenda for public higher education that will be communicated to the governor, the legislature and the people of Idaho.
