1 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE LAVA HOT SPRINGS FOUNDATION FOR FISCAL YEAR  
2 2011; AND LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-  
3 TIONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Lava Hot Springs Foun-  
7 dation the following amounts to be expended according to the designated ex-  
8 pense classes from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2010, through June  
9 30, 2011:

16 SECTION 2. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the  
17 Lava Hot Springs Foundation is authorized no more than thirteen and  
18 eight-tenths (13.8) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the  
19 period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, for the program specified in  
20 Section 1 of this act, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The  
21 Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any  
22 increased positions so authorized.
