REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION FOR THE COMMIS SION FOR PARDONS AND PAROLE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING MONEYS
 TO THE COMMISSION FOR PARDONS AND PAROLE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; LIMITING
 THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; EXEMPTING THE COMMISSION
 FROM CERTAIN APPROPRIATION TRANSFER LIMITATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010;
 EXEMPTING THE COMMISSION FROM CERTAIN APPROPRIATION TRANSFER LIMITA TIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the appropriation made to the Department of Correction for the Commission for Pardons and Parole in Section 1, Chapter 338, Laws of 2009, is hereby reduced by the following amount according to the designated expense classes from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010:

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission for Pardons and Parole the following amount to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011:

32 SECTION 3. AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS. In accordance 33 with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Commission for Pardons and Parole is 34 authorized no more than thirty-two (32) full-time equivalent positions 35 at any point during the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, unless 36 specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations 1 Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so autho-2 rized.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTIONS FROM APPROPRIATION TRANSFER LIMITATIONS FOR FIS-3 CAL YEAR 2010. To provide maximum flexibility in dealing with reduced appro-4 priations for Fiscal Year 2010, the Commission for Pardons and Parole within 5 the Department of Correction is hereby exempted from the provisions of Sec-6 tion 67-3511, Idaho Code, for all moneys appropriated to it for the period 7 July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010. Legislative appropriations shall not 8 9 be transferred from one fund to another fund, however, unless expressly approved by the Legislature. 10

SECTION 5. EXEMPTIONS FROM APPROPRIATION TRANSFER LIMITATIONS FOR FIS-CAL YEAR 2011. To provide maximum flexibility in dealing with reduced appropriations for Fiscal Year 2011, the Commission for Pardons and Parole is hereby exempted from the provisions of Section 67-3511, Idaho Code, for all moneys appropriated to it for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011. Legislative appropriations shall not be transferred from one fund to another fund, however, unless expressly approved by the Legislature.

SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, Sections 1 and 4 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval.
