STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS21184

This legislation amends the provisions of Students Come First that were contained in S1108 (2011) to delete superfluous language and clarify that:

1.) School districts may deliver teacher contracts electronically.

2.) A designee of the school board may declare a position vacant if a teacher contract is not returned in a timely manner.

3.) The provision that allows school districts to suspend employees in cases where a court order prevents the individual from being in contact with children also includes a court order that prevents the individual from being in contact with another employee at the school.

4.) The first portion of the required annual teacher evaluation must be complete by March 1st, rather than before February 1st.

5.) Reassigning an employee from an administrative position to a non-administrative position may include a change in contract terms.

6.) The parties to a Master Agreement must provide written notice of ratification activity.

7.) The State Board of Education may promulgate rules relating to the implementation of school district collective bargaining laws.

8.) The definition of employee benefits is limited to the items listed in statute.
