STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26291

This is the FY 2019 original appropriation bill for the State Independent Living Council. It appropriates \$697,800 and caps the number of authorized full-time equivalent positions at 4.00. For benefit costs, the bill removes \$1,450 per eligible FTP to bring the annual employer contribution for health insurance down to \$11,650 by including a two-month employee and employer premium holiday, adds a 6.8% increase for life insurance, and adjusts funding for workers' compensation in amounts that vary by agency. Inflationary adjustments include \$700 for building rent increases. For statewide cost allocation, there is no fiscal impact, as risk management costs will decrease by \$100, and State Controller fees will increase \$100, for a net change of zero. This bill also provides funding for a 3% ongoing merit-based salary increase for permanent employees, to be distributed at the discretion of the agency head. This bill funds two line items: \$6,600 for an increase in an administrative fee charged by the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Title VII grant; and \$1,300 for IT/Telecommunications upgrades as recommended by the Office of the Chief Information Officer.
