SENATE BILL NO. 1196

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE
2 GENERAL FUND TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; AP-
3 PROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION
4 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE
5 GENERAL FUND TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; AP-
6 PROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION
7 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFEC-
8 TIVE DATE.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

11 SECTION 1. FISCAL YEAR 2023 CASH TRANSFER TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION
12 FUND. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller
13 shall transfer \$85,000,000 from the General Fund to the Parks and Recreation
14 Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30,
15 2023.

16 SECTION 2. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
17 ter 201, Laws of 2022, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
18 hereby appropriated to the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Cap-
19 ital Development Program \$85,000,000 from the Parks and Recreation Fund to
20 be expended for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, for deferred
21 maintenance, capital projects, and collaborative interagency projects.

22 SECTION 3. FISCAL YEAR 2024 CASH TRANSFER TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION
23 FUND. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller
24 shall transfer \$10,000,000 from the General Fund to the Parks and Recreation
25 Fund on July 1, 2023, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period
26 July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024.

27 SECTION 4. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law,
28 there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Parks and Recreation for
29 the Capital Development Program \$10,000,000 from the Parks and Recreation
30 Fund to be expended for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024, for
31 capital projects.

32 SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
33 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-
34 fect on and after passage and approval, and Sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
35 be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
