RELATING TO RULES OF THE DIVISION OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND THE PERSONNEL COMMISSION; AMENDING SECTION 67-5309, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR A CERTAIN LIMITATION ON DEGREE REQUIREMENTS, TO PROVIDE FOR JOB QUALIFICATION EQUIVALENCY THROUGH ALTERNATIVE MEANS, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

HOUSE BILL NO. 434 BY RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE LAND; AMENDING CHAPTER 3, TITLE 58, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 58-304B, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR STANDARD MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES AND TO PROVIDE FOR REMEDIATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
