- 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 10 SECTION 1. That Section 18-3309, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby repealed. 11
  - SECTION 2. That Chapter 33, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and designated as Section 18-3309, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
    - 18-3309. CONCEALED WEAPONS AT PUBLIC COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES. The board of regents of the university of Idaho, the board of trustees of the state colleges and universities, the board for career technical education, and the boards of trustees of each of the community colleges established under chapter 21, title 33, Idaho Code, shall not regulate or prohibit the otherwise lawful possession, carrying, or transporting of firearms or ammunition by any person carrying a concealed weapon pursuant to section 18-3302, 18-3302H, or 18-3302K, Idaho Code.
  - SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
