	Chairman Holtzclaw called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm.
RS 31114:	<b>Rep. Young</b> presented <b>RS 31114</b> to the committee. This legislation helps address the labor shortage in Idaho. <b>RS 31114</b> simplifies the unemployment benefit formula and encourages workers to resume work by adjusting the maximum weeks of unemployment available. Full-time workers are eligible for up to 14 weeks of unemployment. Part-time workers are eligible for up to ten weeks of unemployment. Seasonal workers can access an additional six weeks if they are attached workers; example include forestry, industry, the trades, and construction.
MOTION:	Rep. Healey made a motion to introduce RS 31114. Motion carried by voice vote.
RS 31029:	<b>Rep. Andrus</b> presented <b>RS 31029</b> to the committee. This legislation is meant to prevent unemployed persons from scheduling and not attending interviews merely to meet work search requirements for unemployment. This legislation also increased the required amount of work searches per week from two to five. Additionally, terms are defined.
MOTION:	Rep. Bundy made a motion to introduce RS 31029. Motion carried by voice vote.
ADJOURN:	There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 1:57 pm.
