PRESENTATION:	Administrator, Idaho Division of Career Technical Education (CTE), provided an update about CTE in Idaho (Attachment 1). He shared that the mission of the Idaho Division of CTE was to prepare Idaho's youth and adults for high skilled, in-demand careers. Dr. Long explained CTE programming was offered at the middle school, high school, and post-secondary levels. Programming also included workforce training, adult education, Graduate Equivalency Diplomas (GED), and apprenticeships. He reported exponential growth in secondary CTE programs with an increase in programming across the state and an increase in student participation. He shared successes including higher graduation rates and go on rates for participants in CTE programs versus non-participants. He credited part of the success of the CTE programs to the integral involvement of industry. Dr. Long introduced two students who shared about their positive CTE experiences.
